

## NEW PROCEDURE for Filling 2021 CDL Barrel Liners

Due to the pandemic, CDL had to turn to a new supplier for our CDL barrel liners. These liners are slightly different and have a different filling process. The steps are very simple, but important. Please read them carefully before using your liner!

- 1) Fold the liner as shown in the photo below. It is important to fold over the entire length of the liner. This step is very important in order to prevent air bubbles from forming inside the liner.



- 2) Place the liner inside the barrel and the spout in the CDL holder. The top two corners of the liner must be perpendicular to the holder.



- 3) Pull the sides of the liner to create an X with the top two corners. See photo.



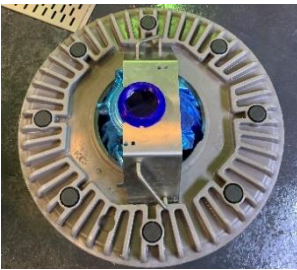
- 4) Start filling the bag.
- 5) Once the liner has around 2 inches (5 centimetres) of liquid in it, take one top corner in each hand and lift, shaking gently. This will allow the liner to fit in the barrel properly and prevent air bubbles from forming at the bottom of the liner.



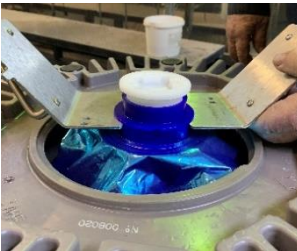
- 6) Leave the upper corners outside the barrel (see photo).



- 7) Continue filling.  
8) When the barrel is around 80% full, tuck the top corners inside the barrel to squeeze out as much air as possible.



- 9) Continue filling until the barrel is full.  
10) Close the liner tightly with the cap provided by your CDL branch. The cap must be touching the syrup directly.
